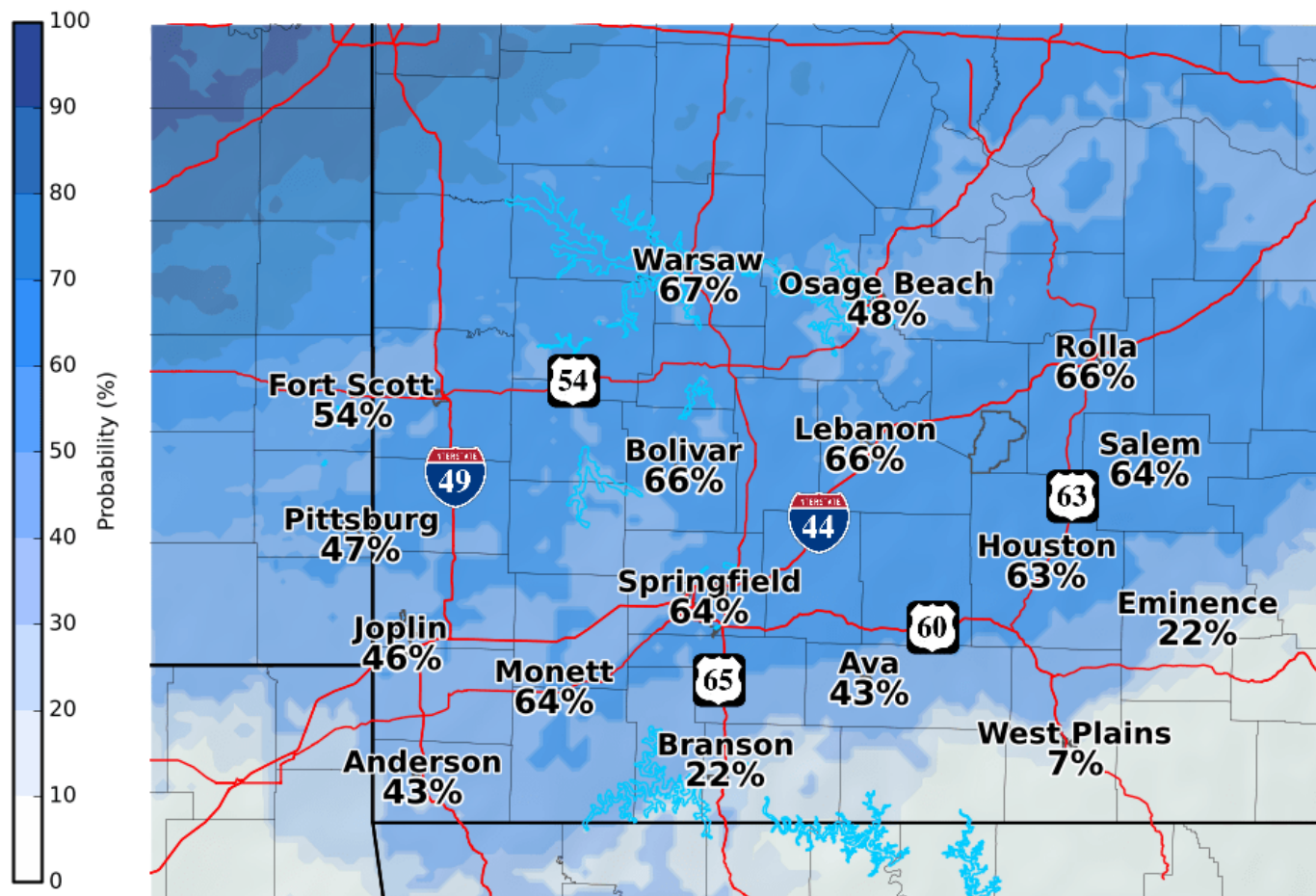




Snow/Rain Mix Late Monday Night into Tuesday Morning

Message of the Day:

- Rain mixed with snow, and a potential changeover to all snow late Monday night into Tuesday. Accumulations would primarily be on elevated and grassy surfaces.
- Widespread frost and possible hard freeze Tuesday Night into Wednesday Morning.
- Additional frost and freeze potential Wednesday night into Thursday morning.
- Rain chances returns Friday into Saturday with a warming trend into the weekend.

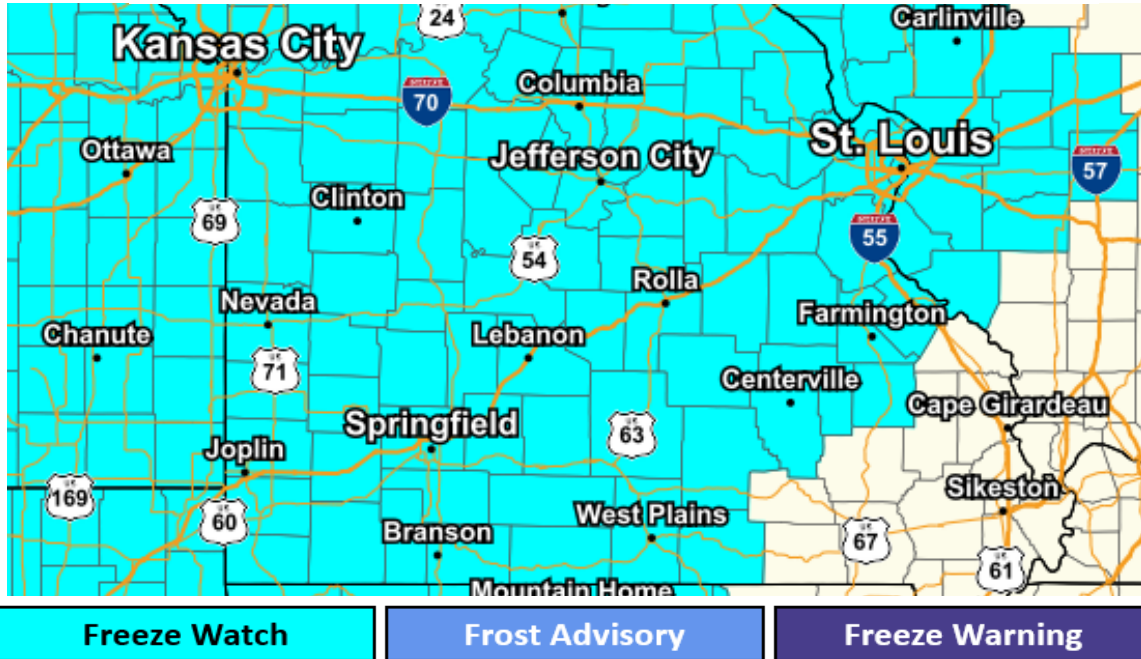
Important Forecast Changes:

- Minor updates to Tuesday snow potential and Wednesday AM low temperatures.

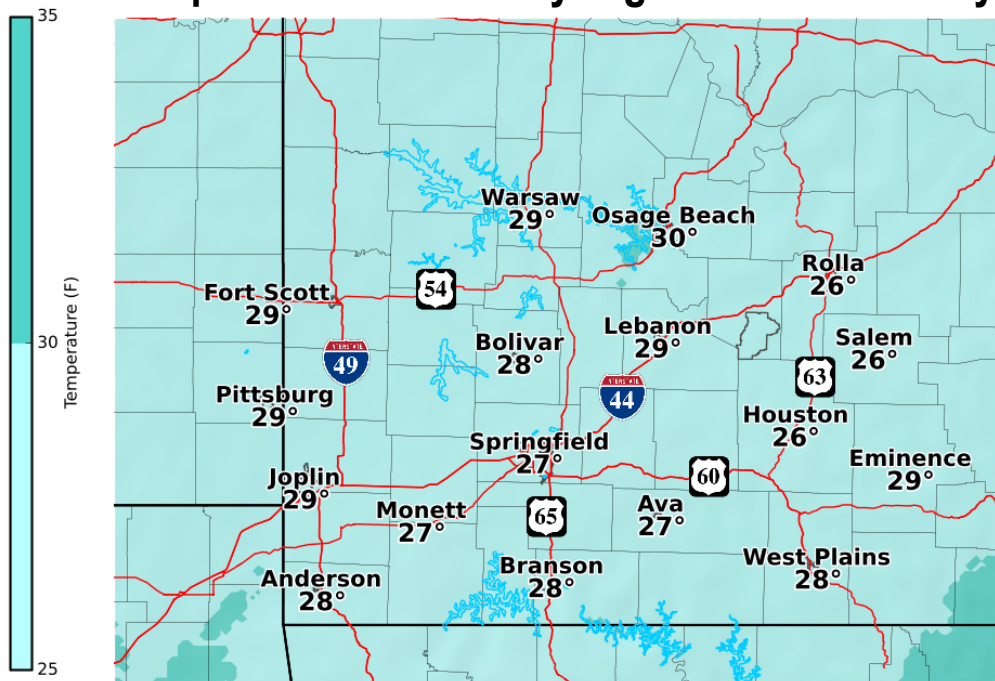

Forecast Low Temperatures Tuesday Night into Wednesday Morning

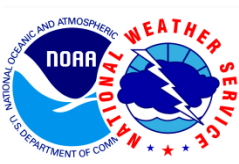
Freeze Watch – 1 AM – 9 AM Wednesday Morning



Forecast Low Temperatures – Tuesday Night into Wednesday Morning

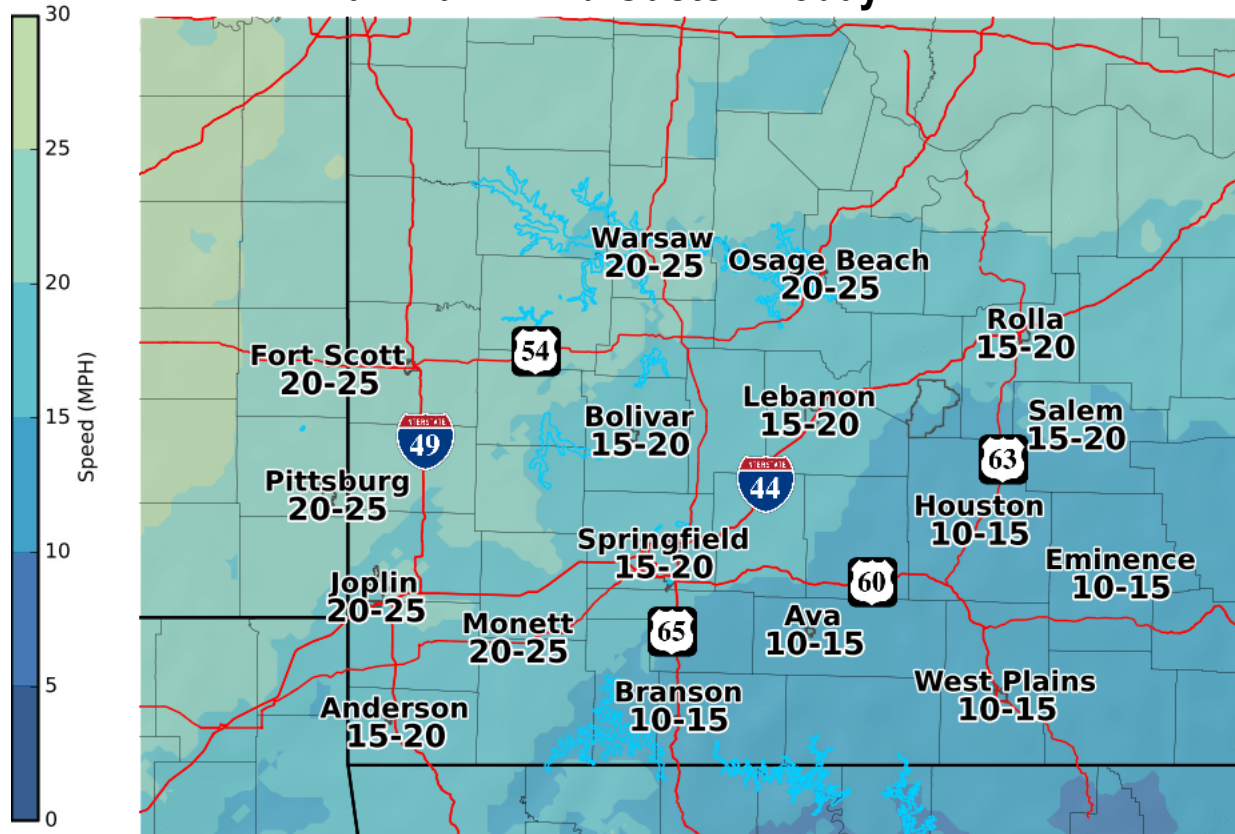


- Widespread frost expected Tuesday night into early Wednesday morning.

- Increasing potential for a hard freeze across the area, especially along the higher terrain of the Missouri Ozark Plateau.

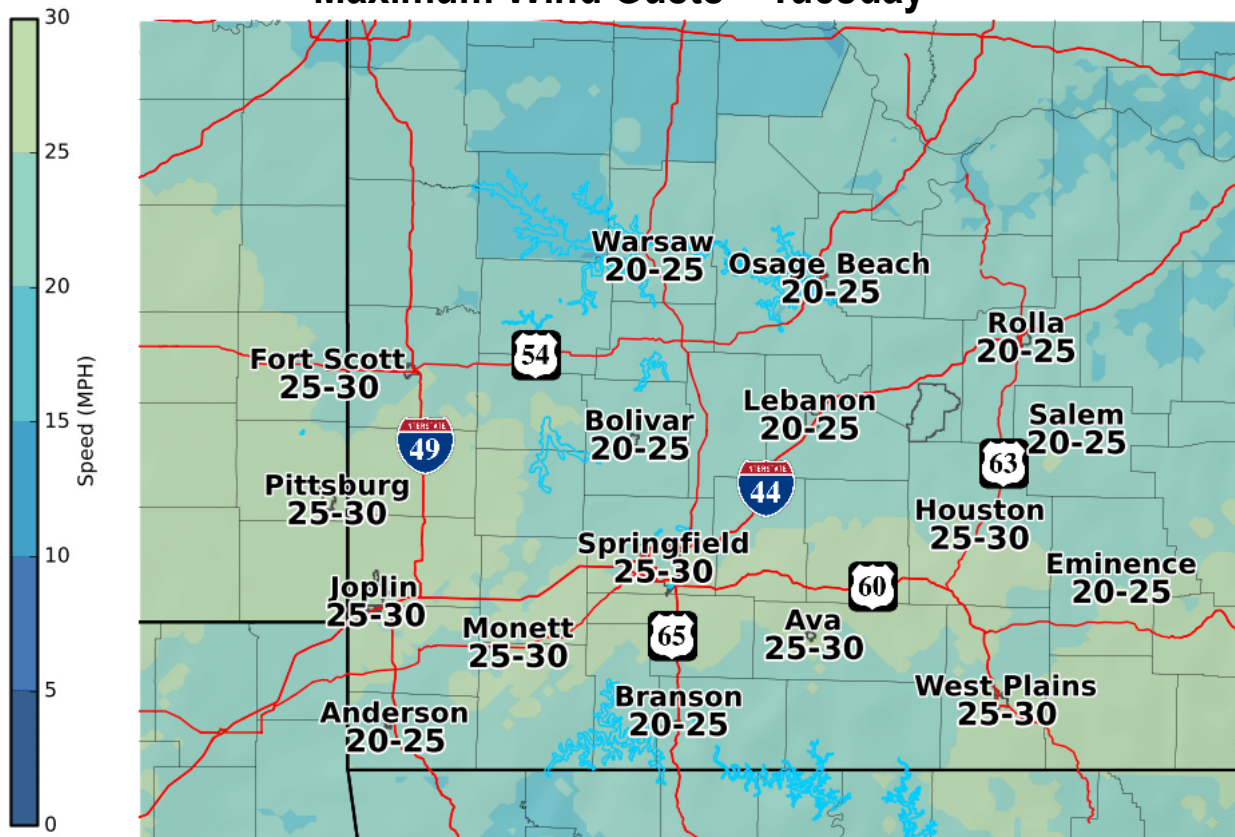


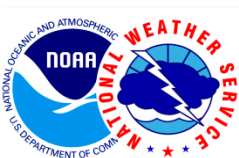
Forecast Maximum Wind Gusts
